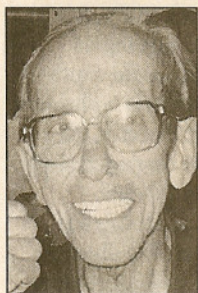


Dollard Bourassa ...Ayer resident; 77

AYER — Dollard "Del" Bourassa, a resident of Ayer for the past 32 years, died
