

Lance Lackens Bibbins passed away peacefully on August 18th at his Nashua NH home, surrounded by his devoted wife Carol and caring nursing staff. He was 89 years old. Mr. Bibbins was a lifelong engineer and learner. He was born in Virginia, Minnesota. After high school and serving on the iron ore freighters and in the Navy, he graduated Purdue University with a degree in electrical engineering, and then obtained his graduate degree from Stevens Institute of Technology. After working to develop the early radar counter-measures systems for ITT, he was a manufacturer's representative for advanced military systems and then founder of two successful technology companies in Massachusetts - Lancer Associates and TRX. For most of his adult life he lived in Littleton, MA. From early retirement through his final days, Mr. Bibbins dedicated himself to such diverse studies as cognitive linguistics, Sanskrit, world spirituality, epigenetics and botany. Of all his interests, he was happiest when designing home inventions or landscaping Bumblebee Park. He is survived by his wife Carol and sons Richard and Neil, and leaves deep impression on the hearts and minds of grandchildren Amanda Rachel, Rory and Liam. He will be missed.
