

# John Tebo...1930-1994

John H. Tebo, 64, of Dahlia Drive, Littleton, died suddenly at his home on Sunday, Sept. 4, 1994. He was born in Waltham on June 19, 1930, the son of the late Joseph and Marie (LeBlanc) Tebo and was the husband of the late Norma (Johanson) Tebo who died in 1982.

Mr. Tebo spent his early life in Weston and attended Weston schools. He had made his home in Littleton since 1953 and worked as an auto mechanic all his life.
