... attended Littleton schools

Lewis Tappan Todd III, of Littleton, Hallandale, Fla., and Waukegan, Ill., died Tuesday, July 13 at his Waukegan home.

Born in Wellesley on Sept. 4, 1924 he was the son of Lilian R. (Durant) Todd of Littleton and the late Lewis Tappan Todd II. He attended Littleton schools.

A decorated U.S. Navy veteran, he served during World War II as a gunners mate aboard the USS Schofield, at the battle of Bari Harbor in Italy.

Mr. Todd was a retired 31 year employee of Airco Gases Co. in Acton, where he worked as an oxygen fill operator.

He was a charter member of the Littleton-Westford Lodge of Elks.

In addition to his mother, survivors include three sisters, Louise E. Hunt and Charlotte T. Hartwell, both of Littleton, and Carol Ann Bennett of Hollis, N.H.; four nieces and four nephews.

Private funeral services were held at the convenience of the family.
