Elmer E. Tracy

49-year Littleton resident, Army vet, WWII; 85

LITTLETON — Elmer E. Tracy, 85, of Littleton, died on December 11, at Emerson Hospital in Concord.

He was born in Sharon, Vermont, June 14 1922, son of the late Merton and Shirley (Kennison) Tracy. He grew up in Montpelier, Vermont and was a graduate of Montpelier High School Class of 1940.

Elmer joined the U.S. Army in WWII from 1940 until 1945. He later returned to rejoin the Army in 1950 and retired in 1966. He served in various places such as the

South Pacific, Camp Pickett, VA, Korea, Ft. Devens, Ludwigsburg and Munich, Germany, and Winthrop Army Base in Boston

Mr. Tracy has made his home in Littleton since 1958.

After his retirement, he worked for Parkside Christian Academy in Boston, and various odd jobs.

He was a member of Grace Chapel in Lexington, and a longtime member of the Groton Baptist Church.

His survivors include his wife of 59 years, Alice (Dunham) Tracy of Littleton; 3 sons, Peter and his wife, Terry Tracy of Littleton, Michael and his wife, Debbie Tracy of Richmond, VA, Daniel Tyler of Seattle; 4 grandchildren, Benjamin Tracy of Chelmsford, Jared Tracy, U.S. Army, Bradley Tracy, U.S. Navy, and MacKenzie Tracy of Richmond, VA, and 7 great-grandchildren, Aiden Tracy, Kaela Tracy, Noah Tracy, Emma Tracy, Sarah Tracy, Eden Tracy and Landen Tracy.

He was also the father of the late Joe Tracy, and the brother of the late Glenn Tracy.
