LITTLETON — Ralph R. Ursch, 63, of 63 Foster St., Littleton, died unexpectedly Jan. 5. He was born Sept. 29, 1922 in Alton, Illinois, son of Agnes (Herrin) Ursch of Alton, Illinois, and the late Victor Ursch.

He served with the U.S. Navy during WWII as a pilot aboard the U.S.S. Intrepid. Ralph received the Silver Star for valor in the Pacific.

He graduated in 1948 from Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri, and then pursued a career in electrical engineering, working 35 years for Raytheon Company in Wal-

tham.

Besides his mother, he is survived by his wife Isabelle (Noel) Ursch of Littleton; three sons — Thomas of Harvard, Ralph R. Jr. of Westford and Andrew of Littleton; and three daughters — Mrs. Michael (Prudence) Henry and Mrs. Paul (Judith) Magee both of Harvard, and Constance Ursch of Littleton. He is also survived by three grandchildren.

A Funeral Mass was held at St. Anne's Church in Littleton, Wednesday Jan. 8, at 10 a.m. Burial was at Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton.
