

Virginia Grace Valcourt ...former 30-year Littleton resident; 62

CHARLESTOWN, N.H. — Virginia Grace (Laushance) Valcourt, 62, of Chase Circle (Hidden Valley) and a former longtime resident of Littleton, Mass., died Thursday morning, April 15, at the Sullivan County Nursing Home after a long illness.

She was the wife of Theodore J. "Paul" Valcourt, who died Monday, April 26, at Springfield Hospital in Springfield, Vt. (Mr. Valcourt's obituary and funeral service announcements appeared in yesterday's editions of *The Sun*.)
