

# 2: Dec. 2, 1987 **Rose Wood**

Rose (Field) Wood, 90, of 20 Meetinghouse Road, Littleton died suddenly at The Nashoba Community Hospital in Ayer, Dec. 2. She was born in Winchester, New Hampshire Sept. 7, 1897, daughter of the late Howard and Etta (Breed) Field. She was the wife of the late George Wood.

Rose had spent her early life in Winchester and grew up on the family farm. She married George in 1917 and had made her home in Littleton since 1920. Along with her husband they owned and operated the first service station in Littleton

called Rosewood Service Station.

She was an active member in the First Baptist Church, a 50-year member of the King's Daughters, and a charter member of the Legion auxillary.

Her survivors include a sister-in-law, Beatrice Field of Littleton, and several nieces and nephews.

A funeral service was held at the Badger Funeral Home on Friday, Dec. 4 with Reverends Kenneth Whitt and John Griffin officiating. Burial was at the Westlawn Cemetery in Littleton.
