LITTLETON — Margaret (Sullivan) Ware, 94, a former longtime resident of Concord, Mass., died yesterday, June 21, at Littleton House Nursing Home. She was the wife of Charles J. Ware, who died in 1988.

She was born in Clinton on Oct. 16, 1904, a daughter of the late William and Katherine (Hobbs) Sullivan. She was a graduate from Clinton High School. She graduated from the Worcester Normal Business School and was married in 1926.
