Robert J. Ware, 53, of 115 Great Road, Littleton, died suddenly at Emerson Hospital in Concord on January 9. He was born in Fitchburg, March 16, 1930, son of Charles and Margaret (Sullivan) Ware. Mr. Ware has made his home in Littleton since 1964 and was employed by the U.S. Postal Service as mail carrier in the Acton area. He spent his early life in Concord and served twenty years in the U.S. Army from which he retired in 1971 as a Master Sergeant. Robert served in Vietnam and was awarded a Bronze Star.
