

MRS. VIVIAN HARLOW WHITE

DIED APRIL 24, 1921

Death.

Mr. and Mrs. Roland G. Houghton and D. G. Houghton attended the funeral of Mrs. Vivian Harlow White in Somerville on Wednesday afternoon, and the burial at the Harlow lot in Westlawn cemetery, Littleton, later in the day. Mrs. White, the beautiful daughter of John and Mary (Kimball) Harlow, was born twenty-five years ago, and until her marriage a few years since had resided with her parents and her two brothers, Myron and Leslie, in Somerville. She is survived by her husband, her father and the brothers. Her death on Sunday, April 24, from valvular heart disease, was not unexpected as she had been out of health for some time, having left her Dedham home a few weeks ago, and returned to her father's, where she and Mr. White could be with the home people at the last. From childhood the deceased had found it necessary to favor her weak heart. Her mother's death occurred about a year ago.
