NASHUA, N.H. — George P. Benham, 88, died at Greenbriar Nursing Facility in Nashua on July 3. He was the husband of Mary (O'Brien) Benham, who died in 1981.

He was born in Arlington on November 25, 1912, a son of the late John and Mary (Sullivan) Benham. He grew up in Arlington and attended the Arlington School System. Mr. Benham worked as a service representative for Addressograph Multigraph of Boston for over 40 years retiring in 1968. He then worked as a custodian for the Littleton School System for 10 years.
