David G. Williams, 69, of Littleton and Deer Isle, Maine, died Feb. 1, 1988 at Eastern Maine Medical Central in Bangor, Maine following surgery for cancer.

He was born in Newton, Massachusetts, Sept. 18, 1918, son of the late Gluyas and Margaret (Kempton) Williams. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and received his bachelor of science Degree from Hamline College in St. Paul, Minnesota in 1950.
