

RICHARD T. BARROW

Richard T. Barrow, a resident of Littleton for the past 66 years and well-known in this area, died at his Nagog Hill road home Monday night. Born in England, Sept. 12, 1868, he had operated a large farm in the Newtown section ever since coming to the community over 65 years ago. He was an attendant of the Littleton Orthodox Congregational church and a charter member and past master of Littleton Grange No. 420 as well as a past member of Middlesex Worcester Pomona Grange No. 3, serving his term as master in 1915. There are no known relatives, Miss Fannie C. Knapp and Miss Edith C. Jenkins making their homes at the Barrow homestead for the past six years.
