Edward T. Byrne, 61, of Littleton, died Friday, June 5, 1998, at Emerson Hospital in Concord. He was the husband of Barbara (Hall) Byrne.

Born in Milford, he was the son of the late William and Loretta (Murray) Byrne. He moved to Weston at the age of 3 and attended St. Joseph's Academy in Wellesley and St. Sabastian's School. He moved to Littleton in 1953 and graduated from Littleton High School in 1954.

Mr. Byrne was a graduate of Stockbridge School of Agriculture where he received a degree in dairy technology. He owned and operated Dell Dale Farms in Littleton until his retirement in 1986. Most recently, he owned and operated the Nashoba Package Store in Littleton.

He was a member of the University of Massachusetts Alumni Association, The Alliance for the Mentally Ill, the Massachusetts Package Store Association, the National Package Store Association and was an avid New England Patriot's fan.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Loretta R.
