Dear Honorable Members of the Zoning Board of Appeals:

This office represents the Applicant in connection with the Application for Use and Dimensional Variances before the Town of Littleton Board of Appeals (the "Board"). The Board continued the prior hearing to, Thursday, July 15, 2010 to allow the Applicant to continue to work with the Town of Littleton (the "Town") toward making Town-owned property located at 521 Great Road, Littleton, Massachusetts (the "Town Property") available for use for a wireless communications facility.

As previously discussed with the Board at a prior public hearing, there are a number of steps required to ensure that the Town Property can be utilized for wireless communications purposes. The Applicant and the Town are actively working together to make the Town Property available, but all of the necessary steps have not yet been completed. Further, the Applicant does not anticipate that these steps will be complete by the Board's public hearing on July 15, 2010.

Accordingly, in order to allow the Applicant and the Town additional time to work together to ensure the availability of the Town Property for wireless communications purposes, the Applicant respectfully requests the Board to continue the public hearing scheduled for July 15, 2010 to the Board's regularly scheduled meeting in September 2010.

Based on this request, the Applicant respectfully requests that its representatives not be required to appear at the hearing on July 15th. Please contact me if a representative will be required to attend.

In addition, the deadline by which the Board must file its written decision pursuant to Chapter 40A, Section 15 of the General Laws of Massachusetts ("Section 15"), and pursuant to FCC guidelines, was previously extended by agreement. Accordingly, the Applicant agrees to further extend the time for the Board to file its written decision to and including October 30, 2010.

Please confirm the Board's agreement by executing in the space provided below. In addition, pursuant to Section 15 a copy of this agreement must be filed with the Town Clerk. Please have the Town Clerk time-stamp the fully-executed copy and return a copy bearing the Town Clerk's time-stamp to me.
