William Coulter

William A. Coulter, 67, of 46 Shaker Lane, died Sept. 26 at Emerson Hospital in Concord.

He was born in Lowell, Mar. 3, 1921, son of the late John and Anne (Moran) Coulter and was the husband of the late Olga Costigan Coulter who died in 1985.
