GROTON — Randy S. Coupal, 41, a Lowell native and former Littleton resident, died unexpectedly Saturday, March 18, at his home in Groton.

He was born in Lowell on June 12, 1958, a son of Jean (Champagne) (Coupal) Walker and Arthur Coupal, who died in 1964. He grew up in Littleton and was a graduate of Littleton High School, Class of 1976.

Mr. Coupal worked at Wang Labs until the mid 1980s and then spent a few years in the Florida Keys. He moved back to Massachusetts and worked for Clint Anderson for a short time. Mr. Coupal then moved to Claremont, N.H. where he worked as a biomedical technician for Creative Biomolecule in Lebanon, N.H. and most recently Cierce in Lexington.

Mr. Coupal enjoyed the outdoors, fishing and ham radio.
