Founder of Alateen group

Clarisse (Chouinard) Cornuet, 78, of Littleton, formerly of Westford, died Tuesday, June 23, 1998. She was the former wife of George A. Cornuet.

Born in Fitchburg, she was the daughter of the late Alfred and Marie (Taylor) Chouinard. She spent her early life in Fitchburg and was a graduate of Fitchburg High School.
