YORK HARBOR, Maine — Kathleen J. (Knox) Cone, 77, of York Harbor, but formerly a resident of Littleton, Mass., for more than seven decades, died yesterday, Nov. 1, at York Hospital in York. She was the wife of the late Clinton Cone.

Born in Littleton on June 23, 1923, she was the daughter of the late Edwin and Winifred (Cousins) Knox. She was a graduate of Littleton High School. The Cones were married in 1949. She lived in Littleton until moving to Maine two years ago.
