

Stanley F. Conant

84 Years Old

LITTLETON — Stanley F. Conant, 84, of 28 Shattuck Street died Friday, December 24 at the Suburban Manor Nursing Home in Acton. He was born May 15, 1892, son of the late Waldo and Elizabeth (Wright) Conant and was a lifelong resident of Littleton.

He was the husband of the late Josephine (Love) Conant, and also of the late Mary (Robinson) (Harvey) Conant.

He attended Boston University, served in the U.S. Army in World War I, and was a charter member of the American Legion Post #249.

He retired 14 years ago as the manager of the Conant-Houghton division of the United Elastic Corporation in Littleton. He was an active member in the Congregational Church in Littleton, where he had been a superintendent of the Sunday Schools, a deacon and trustee and was made a Deacon emeritus by the board of deacons on March, 1974 for his service to the church. He was a cemetery commission for many, many years, and was also a member of the Historical Society and was interested in conservation and wildlife.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Hugh (Mary) Whitman of Darien, Conn.; a sister, Margaret of Berkeley, Calif; also, four grandchildren and a great granddaughter.
