

## Long Lake West – Easy Hike

This walk is along a wide dirt road. It's less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile round trip down to Long Lake and back. You may have to take the small trail around a large puddle in the road if it has been raining. If you're up to a little bit more exploring, you can follow the rest of the trail loop, but it does get narrower, with some roots and rocks. It tracks near the shoreline of Long Lake. All the trails on this side of Long Lake Park are relatively flat. You can get a full description and maps of all the trails at the Littleton Conservation Trust page:
