

Newtown Hill – Easy Hike

This walk is along the paved access road to the water tank. It's less than $\frac{1}{2}$ mile round trip up and back. The footing is quite good since it is paved, but it is a bit of a climb! You're rewarded with some great views at the top. There is parking for a few cars at the Community Gardens. If you feel adventurous you can follow the trail at the gardens across the field and into the woods, but footing through the field can be a bit tricky and the trail is not always well trod. It leads you to a hidden field (and beyond).
