

Hartwell Family Memorial Preserve – Easy Hike

This walk is along a fairly wide and even trail, and can be done as a loop. It's about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile round trip down to the stone bridge with views of Beaver Brook and its meadows. There is plenty of parking, and you can follow the red trail, straight through the gate.
