Thomas R. Casey, former Littleton police officer

LITTLETON — Thomas R. Casey, 39, of 140 Great Rd., a former Littleton police officer, died Thursday at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute, Boston after a lengthy illness.

He was born in Somerville, January 21, 1944, a son of Timothy and Blanche (Cochran) Casey of Concord.

He had resided in Littleton since 1969 and was a Littleton police officer since 1977.

He was a member of the U.S. Coast Guard during the Vietnam era, a member of the Naval Reserve and the National Guard Military Police.

He was a board member of the Alpha Omega of Littleton, the Department of Youth Services and the Littleton Youth Advisory Council.

He was also a Juvenile Probation Officer at the Ayer District Court, a member of the Boston Police Emerald Society, a life member of the Irish American Club of Westford and a communicant of St. Anne's Church of Littleton.

Besides his parents, he is survived by his wife, Marjorie (Doherty) Casey of Littleton; a son, Timothy John Casey of Bedford; two stepsons, Michael and Christopher Tripp; three stepdaughters, Nancy, Kathleen and Maureen Tripp, all of Littleton; two brothers, Timothy Casey of Westford and David Casey of Bridgewater.
