LeRoy F. Caple ... Littleton, worked at GM; 70

LITTLETON — LeRoy F. Caple, 70, a Littleton resident who had worked as an inspector for General Motors in Framingham until he retired in 1989, died on Thursday, Nov. 28, at his home. He was the husband of Barbara (Pacy) Caple for 47 years.



He was born in Hornel, N.Y., on May 4, 1932, a son of the late Charles and Charlotte (Monroe) Caple. He grew up in Andover, N.Y., and graduated from Andover Central High School in 1950. He later moved to Littleton in 1955 and lived there for the remainder of his life. Mr. Caple served in the U.S. Air Force for four years during the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the American Legion. He also was an avid sports fan and enjoyed fishing.
