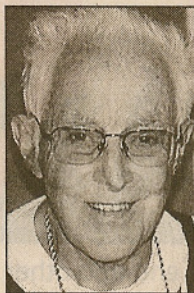
George B. Caldwell... longtime resident of Littleton, was Minuteman; 84

LITTLETON — George B. Caldwell, 84, a longtime Littleton resident, died yesterday, July 26, at his home after a brief illness. He was the husband of Priscilla (Currier) Caldwell.

He was born in Bridgeton, N.J., on Aug. 5, 1921, son of the late Harold and Olive (Brown) Caldwell. He graduated from Littleton High School in 1939. He attended the University of Massachusetts for three years.

For many years, Mr. Caldwell owned and operated the Caldwell Poultry Farm in Littleton. In 1960, he worked at Bowl-Mor Corp. in Littleton. Before retiring in 1990, he was employed for 24 years as a purchasing director with New England Apple Products in Littleton. He also sold perennial plants from his home.

Mr. Caldwell was an avid marathon runner, and was the only participant to run in both the



50th and 100th Boston Marathons in 1946 and 1996, according to family members. He was a corporator for Emerson Hospital in Concord and a member of the Littleton Congregational Church. He was a charter member of the Littleton Minutemen, marching in many parades. He was also a member of Tahattawan Masonic Lodge AF/AM in Littleton. He enjoyed walking.

Besides his wife, survivors include a son, Thomas Caldwell of Concord; two daughters, Dorothy McMillan and Barbara Caldwell-Miller, both of Westford; two sisters, Nancy Marzullo of Malden and Jean Dunn of Marlboro; and eight grandchildren, Rachel and Russell Caldwell of Concord, Jeff and Sam McMillan, Christopher, Matthew, Kim-Elizabeth and Michelle Miller, all of Westford.
