Notice of Intent




Figure 2 - Crossing 1

The trail at Oak Hill – Sanderson Esker provides a loop from the main Oak Hill parking lot to the newer parking lot on the AT&T easement, further south down Oak Hill Road. Figure 1 shows general locations and Figure 2 shows photographs. The proposed plans for the two boardwalks are provided in Attachment A. Attachment B provides the Littleton Bylaw Waiver Request. Notice of Intent Forms are in Attachment C. Abutter notification information is in Attachment D.

Crossing 1 is approximately 13 feet long and will be placed on ledgers on either side of the resource areas. One plastic pipe may be required in the mudflat for additional support. This will be approximately 6 inches over 10 foot width, or 5 square feet. The crossing location was chosen as it is relatively narrow, relatively stone free and would not require removal of vegetation. This crossing will replace several informal crossing areas where stepping stones have been placed in the stream or cut saplings have been piled to allow footing through the stream. The new boardwalk will mitigate these wetland impacts and the branches/saplings in particular will be removed (approximately 30 square feet) so they do not impeded flow.

Crossing 2 is approximately 8 feet long and will be placed on ledgers on either side of the resource area. No middle support will be needed. The crossing area is very rocky, but the location has been chosen to avoid having to move numerous boulders or cut vegetation. The informal crossing right now requires stepping across slippery boulders or cutting across the wetland when water levels are lower, which is causing compression of the wetland soils. The new boardwalk will mitigate these wetland impacts.

Both boardwalks will be 4 feet wide. Work will be done by hand to avoid any secondary impacts, and the ledgers to support the boardwalk will be outside the resource areas. Materials will be brought in by tractor and cart with no wetland crossing. The crossings were located so that no tree cutting or shrub removal is anticipated. The trails are already in place so no additional trail clearing will be required.

This project is part of the recent ongoing boardwalk initiative which has seen boardwalks built at Cloverdale, Hartwell, Morrison Trail, Town Forest, Williams and Yapp. These boardwalks have been variously funded by the Conservation Department, donations of both cash and materials, and funding by the Community Preservation Committee, Littleton Electric Light and Water, and MA Department of Conservation and Recreation Trail Grants. Other than two boardwalks at Town Forest, these boardwalks have all been built by volunteer labor and the Littleton Conservation Trust. Several Eagle Scout projects have funded and built three boardwalks (most recently) and a set of steps at Town Forest.





PLAN FOR BOARDWALK #1 at SANDERSON ESKER


