## Agnes E. Durkee

### Devoted Wife, Mother and Grandmother, 89

Littleton — Agnes E. (Butler) Durkee, 89 of Briny Breezes, FL and Littleton died following a stroke at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston on October 8. She was born on April 5, 1918 daughter of the late Horace and Mary Katherine (Bannon) Butler. She was the beloved and cherished wife of Sidney P.
