As the busy days of summer come to an end, we hope you have had a chance to enjoy all that our department has to offer. We have had an amazing summer and are so grateful for your support of our parks and recreation programs.

We are writing to share some exciting news and ask for your support in the upcoming year. We have many projects in various stages happening within the Parks & Rec right now. Many of these project will need support from the residents at Fall and Spring Town Meeting. We hope to see you at those meeting to show your support of our department.

We are reaching the completion of the 2023 Open Space and Recreation Plan that is due to the Department of Conservation and Recreation in November. We have our 3rd and last public hearing on September 21st at the Sturtz Room from 7PM to 9PM. This will be the last time the public can add content to the report.

We are also conducting a statistically valid survey this fall to update our 10-year strategic plan. The survey will be conducted by a research firm and will have an accuracy rating of 95% or greater. If you are selected to participate in the survey we would truly appreciate you taking your time to share your input on our programs and facilities.

Additionally, we are bringing two projects to Fall Town Meeting to be funded through the Community Preservation Committee. The first project is to replace tennis courts that will be demolished to make room for a new senior center. The second project is to install LED lights on Koerper Field to help with the lack of athletic field space available in town.

Lastly, at some point in the next year we will be looking to renovate the newly purchase 36 King Street. Ultimately, we would like to see this turn into our long term home of the PRCE department. Your support can help us see this dream completed sooner than later.

We are always here for the community of Littleton, and we appreciate your continued support. If you have any questions or suggestions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Cancellations

- PRCE reserves the right to cancel and/or combine any program with insufficient enrollment within 7 days prior to the class's start date. All participants will be notified of changes in schedule.
- When public schools are closed for either school/town events or due to inclement weather, programs will not be held. Classes will be rescheduled at a later date.

DON'T DELAY!

Many of our classes fill up fast, so sign up NOW before it's too late. We decide a week before the start date whether or not to run classes with low enrollment;

Refund Policy

Our programming is 100% funded by course fees. Our refund policies are strictly adhered to.

- In the event a course is canceled due to low enrollment, you will receive a full refund in the manner in which you paid.
- Pro-rated refunds will only be given if a canceled class cannot be rescheduled.
- To process your refund, you must respond to the cancellation email within 30 days; otherwise, we will process the refund as a household credit.
- In the case of a medical withdrawal, a refund minus a 10% administration fee will be processed when accompanied by a doctor's note.
- Any requests for refunds fewer than five days before a program start will not be granted. All other withdrawal fees will be determined by the PRCE Director and accompanied by a 20% processing fee.
- Refunds will only be given via household credit, check, and credit card. Credit Card refunds will be processed within 5 to 7 business days. Refunds issued by check will be processed within 2 to 4 weeks.
- PRCE reserves the right to change the program location and/or programming staff if needed. Refunds will not be given if this occurs.

Transfer Policy

You may request to transfer into another class if:

- The request is made before the 2nd meeting of the class.
- There is space available on the roster for the class that you would like to transfer into.
- The minimum participation number is still met for the class that you are currently enrolled in.
- A \$15.00 transfer fee is paid in full.

Drop-In Policy

- You must register and pay for a drop-in prior to participating.
- Present your receipt, paper or email, to the instructor upon arrival to your session.
- Instructors cannot accept cash or check payment.

FACILITY INFORMATION AND DIRECTION

Littleton Town Hall

PRCE Studio 1 & 2

41 Shattuck Street, second floor. The entrance located at the front of Town Hall. Enter the building through the sliding doors, walk through the lobby and up the stairs. The fitness studios will be to your left. Parking is available behind Town Hall and a few spots on the side of the building.

Town Hall Multi-Purpose Room & Senior Diner

33 Shattuck Street, entrance located in the far right corner of the 33 Shattuck Court yard. Parking available behind Town Hall. Spaces closest to the tennis courts allow the easiest access.

Room 103

37 Shattuck Street, entrance is located on the 1st floor in the middle of Town Hall (to the right of LCTV and the green dumpsters.) Parking available behind Town Hall.

Tennis Courts

33 Shattuck Street. Parking available behind Town Hall.

41 Shattuck Street, 3rd floor. Parking is available behind or on the side of Town Hall. Entrance in the front or back of Town Hall.

Littleton Public Schools

Shaker Lane Elementary

35 Shaker Lane, main entrance located off the corner of Roxbury Drive and Goldsmith Street. Secondary entrance off Shaker Lane.

Russell Street Elementary

57 Russell Street, entrance road located just south of 495 on Russell Street. Follow road around Alumni field to the entrance of the school. Limited parking is available to the right of the rotary.

Littleton Middle School

55 Russell Street, entrance road located just south of Highland Lane on Russell Street. Parking lot entrance and exits follow one-way traffic pattern.

Littleton High School

56 King Street, entrance located off King Street between St. Anne's Church and Indian Hill Music School. Caution lights mark the entrance road. All indoor programming should follow the road up to the top parking lot and enter the main school entrance. The lower parking lot can be used for access to tennis courts, baseball and softball fields.



PRCE Locations in the Community

Fay Park

20 Foster Street, located next to the renovated Littleton Fire Station.

Long Lake Beach

20 Town Road. Access to the beach parking lot is located at the end of Town Road off Goldsmith Street. Access to the State Boat Ramp is located at 11 Meadowbrook Road. Limited short-term parking is available at the boat ramp; this parking is only available to those using the boat ramp to launch a watercraft.

300 King Street (Castle in the Trees)

300 King Street, Littleton, MA 01460. Playgrounds, basketball courts, and walking path.

Alumni Field

55 Russell Street. It is the football field that is located between the Middle and Russell St Schools. The road that leads to the field is next to the Middle School and bends around to the left. The field is fenced in, and you can't miss the stadium seating. Parking is limited next to the field, and primary parking is the Middle School Field. It is a very short walk to the field from there.

Intro to Cold Process Soap Making

This class will introduce you to the basics of making cold process soap. Cold process soaps are created by blending oils (or fat) with a lye mixture. In turn, the soap saponifies over the next twenty-four hours turning the lye-oil mixture into a solid bar of soap! The class will cover the following:

- Necessary materials, supplies, and equipment
- Safety considerations when working with sodium hydroxide
- Taking accurate measurements and proper mixing temperatures
- Coloring your soap (micas, labcolors, herbs, spices and clays)

- Preparing your molds and molding options
- Insulating, cutting, curing and storing your finished soap







01. Statistically Valid Recreational Needs Survey

At the end of August recreational needs surveys will be sent out to random households in Littleton. This is a different survey from the Open Space and Recreation Plan survey that went out in July.

This one is specifically for the Parks, Recreation, and Community Education Department to help us create a 10 year strategic plan for what the community wants from our department in the future. This includes facilities, programs, parks, and special events.

If you receive one of these surveys in the mail we would greatly appreciate if you would take the time to complete it.



Muscot: Total Light Control is the system that we will be installing.

02. LED Lights at Koerper Field

This project is a solution to deal with the increasing loss of athletic fields in Littleton. Currently we are down 8 athletic fields and may potentially lose a 9th during the construction of the new Senior Center.

Installing of LED lights will allow Koerper Field to operate the same hours in Summer during the Fall and Spring season. This will increase the number of hours that youth sports have access to the field.

This project is eligible for the Community Preservation Funds. Approval of funding this project will be on the October 30th, 2023 Town Meeting Warrant.

03. New Tennis Courts at LHS

This project will reconfigure the High School Tennis courts from two courts to four courts. This project is the current solution to replace the two tennis courts that will be demolished to build the new senior center.

This project is also eligible for the Community Preservation Funds. Approval of funding this project will be on the October 30th, 2023 Town Meeting Warrant.



04. Renovation to 36 King Street

At the February 2023 Special Town Meeting that Town of Littleton purchased 36 King Street, formerly known as the Indian Hill Music School with the intention to make it a home for Parks, Recreation, and Community Education and the Littleton Public Schools Central Office.

At some point this fiscal year a plan and a cost estimate to renovate this building will come before the residents of Littleton for funding at a Town Meeting. This is still to be determined.
