LITTLETON — George F. Dufour, 62, a Littleton resident and local business owner, died unexpectedly Tuesday, Aug. 24, at Emerson Hospital in Concord. He was the husband of Lorraine (Barbagallo) Dufour.

He was born in Ayer on March 30, 1942, a son of Julia (Roberts) Towne of Littleton and the late Kenneth Dufour. He spent his youth in Harvard and Littleton and attended the Littleton school system.
