LOWELL — Rosemary (Drummond) Dubeau, 79, died yesterday afternoon, Dec. 26, at Northwood Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, after a brief illness. She was the wife of the late Kenneth Dubeau.

She was born in Newburyport on July 25, 1922, a daughter of the late Charles and Mary E. (McLaughlin) Drummond, and graduated from St. Bernard's High School in Fitchburg. She also attended classes at Merrimack College.

Mrs. Dubeau had lived in Lowell for the past 40 years and had worked as a bookkeeper for the Army Air Force Post Exchange at Fort Devens and the Fitchburg Paper Co. She retired in 1983 from McQuesten's Lumber in Billerica.
