Beatrice Dodds

...retired Littleton schoolteacher; 93

LITTLETON — Beatrice (Blood) Dodds, 93, a Littleton resident and former schoolteacher in town, died Friday, Jan. 2, at the Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley in Littleton. She was the wife of Richard W. Dodds, who died in 1981.

She was born in Groton on June 26, 1910, a daughter of Lawrence and Ethel (Baldwin) Blood. She graduated from Groton High School in 1928 and Fitchburg State Teacher College in 1930.

For 31 years, Mrs. Dodds was an elementary school teacher in Orange. She later taught the first grade in Littleton for 11 years. She was a member of the Massachusetts Retired Teachers Association and the National Retired Teachers Association.

She was also a member of the King's Daughters in Littleton and the Littleton Congregational Church.

Survivors include two nephews, two nieces, two great-nieces, three great-great-nieces and three great-great-nephews.
