

WILLIAM DODDS

DIED APRIL 24, 1922

William Dodds entered the larger life on Monday, April 24, after a long decline that followed a severe attack of influenza, experienced nine weeks ago. Funeral services were held from Mr. Dodds' late home on Wednesday afternoon, his pastor, Rev. Chester A. Wheeler, officiating. There was a variety of choice floral tributes from friends and former associates. The burial was in Westlawn cemetery.

The deceased is survived by his wife, a son, J. William Dodds, and three grandchildren.

Mr. Dodds was born in England seventy-one years ago last December, and with his wife and the son came to this country many years ago, settling first in New York state and later in Chelsea. They moved to Littleton about twenty-six years ago, when Mr. Dodds entered the employ of Conant & Houghton as weaver, a position he held until within recent years when he bought the farm which he since carried on.

He was a loyal member of the Congregational church which he regularly attended in the days of his health. He enjoyed a good reputation and was a kind friend, being especially sympathetic and helpful to people who were sick or otherwise unfortunate. His family have the sympathy of their friends in their bereavement.
