...Littleton resident nearly 75 years; 94

LITTLETON— Vera (Taylor) Davidson, 94, a Littleton resident for more than seven decades, died at Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley on Aug. 13. She was the wife of the late John N. Davidson.

She was born in Amherst, Nova Scotia, on Jan. 22, 1906, a daughter of Lorne and Mamie (Hickey) Taylor. She came to the United States from Canada when she was 20 years old and made her home in Littleton the rest of her life.
