LITTLETON — Virginia (Fletcher) Edwards, 89, formerly of Littleton, died at Concord Health Care Center in Concord on April 29.

She was born in Charlestown, MA on March 6, 1920 daughter of the late Russell and Olive (Knights) Fletcher, and the wife of the late Franklin B. Edwards, Sr. who died in 1995. She grew up in Medford and was a graduate of the Medford School System. Virginia summered at Long Lake in Littleton and spent many summers on the family farm on Fletcher Lane, Littleton. She was married on October 24, 1937, and made her in Littleton until 2005 when she moved to Concord.
