Dear Commissioners:

Enclosed please find 2 copies of a Request for Determination of Applicability (“RDA”) filed by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (“MassDOT”) concerning a proposal to resurface Rt 2 in Littleton, Boxborough, and Acton (the “project”).

This 6.3 milling and resurfacing project consists of milling and resurfacing the existing mainline, ramps, bridge decks, and buffers of the Rt 2 highway. The bridge decks over Central St, Foster St and the Route 111 ramp bridge over Route 2 West shall be included with this project. The work also includes bridge decks over the MBTA/BMRR will also be resurfaced. The related work includes clearing for maintaining sight, and maintaining drainage structures, replacing damaged frames and grate covers with in the traveled way, and resetting the granite curb.

A small portion of the work occurs within the buffer zones of natural watercourses and bordering vegetated wetlands. Prior to construction, sediment control barriers will be installed to protect and prevent encroachment into environmentally sensitive areas.

As this Project meets the exemptions under 310 CMR10.02(2)(b)(2), MassDOT is requesting that the Commission Issue a Negative Determination number five: The area described in the Request is subject to jurisdiction under the Act. Since the work described therein meets the requirements for the exemption, as specified in the Act and the regulations, no Notice of Intent is required.

In that MassDOT Highway Division is an agency of the Commonwealth, the enclosed RDA is being filed solely under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (“WPA”) regulations, and not under any local wetland’s bylaw including payments of any filing fees or abutter notifications. The work proposed primarily consists of milling and resurfacing the existing mainline, ramps, and bridge within right of way, and related work. Related work including clearing for site line distance and replacing damaged frames and grates/covers within the traveled way; resetting granite curb, granite curb inlets, and granite edging; replacing hot mix asphalt berm; and maintaining drainage structures. Erosion and sediment controls will be installed prior to work commencing. The erosion controls will consist of compost filter tubes, and silt sacks in catch basins.





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

LIMITS OF MILLING AND PAVING AT THE NORTH WESTERN END OF LITTLETON




LIMITS OF MILLING AND PAVING AT THE CENTRAL STREET RAMPS
