Luther Furbush

Luther B. Furbush, 93, of 25 Bulkeley Road, Littleton, died accidentally on Oct. 21. He was born in Boxborough July 10, 1891, son of the late Wm. and Emily (Raymond) Furbush and was the husband of the late Avis (Barlow) Furbush.

Luther spent his early life in Boxborough and was a graduate of Concord High School. In 1919, he served in the U.S. Army during World War I, and then returned to Littleton to the Bulkeley Farm and operated the family farm as a dairy farmer and orchardist.

He had been a member of the Boxborough Grange and was a pastmaster of both the Boxboro Grange and Littleton Grange. He was a member of the Littleton American Legion Post #249; a member of the Boxboro Congregational Church; an honorary life member of the Littleton Historical Society; and a very active supporter of the Littleton Playhouse.

Mr. Furbush is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Bert (Carolyn) Webster of Littleton; two brothers, Arthur H. Furbush of Boxborough and Fred C. Furbush of Southbridge; five grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the First Baptist Church of Littleton on Wednesday at 2 pm. Burial was at Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton. Funeral directors, Wm. A. Badger & Sons.
