

Lennart Fougstedt...1911-1994

Lennart "Lennie" W. Fougstedt, 83, of Mill Road died at Littleton House Nursing Home Saturday, Nov. 26, 1994 after a brief illness.

He was born in Somerville Aug. 15, 1911, son of the late Louis and Bertha (Skoog) Fougstedt. Mr. Fougstedt attended schools in Lexington and Bedford.

Prior to his retirement, Mr. Fougstedt had been the superintendent of Westlawn Cemetery in Littleton for 17 years. He had also been employed at Veryfine in Littleton for 27 years. He served as a call firefighter in town as well as a reserve police officer, dog officer, civil defense, and was a member of the Board of Registration of voters. He also served in the Massachusetts State Guard during World War II.

Besides his involvement in his community, Mr. Fougstedt was active in his church, serving as an usher at St. Anne's for 40 years as well as being an active member of the Holy Name Society.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Mary "Susie" (Sullivan) Fougstedt of Littleton; four daughters, Mary Crory, Martha McKenna and Susan Fougstedt, all of Littleton, and Karen Watson of Clearwater, Fla.; a brother, Allan Fougstedt of St. Petersburg, Fla.; two sisters, Anna Young and Eleanor O'Malley, both of Bedford; 18 grandchildren; 31 great grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews. He was also the brother of the late Lawrence Fougstedt.
