... a World War II veteran

Donald H. Ford, 76, of Hemet, Calif., formerly of Littleton, died June 12 at the Hemet Valley Medical Center in California.

He was born in Seabring, Fla., son of the late George and Grace (Newbury) Ford. He spent his early life in Littleton and was a graduate of Littleton High School.

He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. Mr. Ford then moved to California where he worked for the U.S. government in the electronics field. He had made his home in Hemet for the past eight years.
