...73 years in Littleton, was deacon; 94

LITTLETON — Mildred (Massie) Fletcher, 94, a Littleton resident more than seven decades, where she was an active member and former deacon of The Congregational Church, died Thursday, Feb. 28, at the Lifecare Center of Nashoba Valley in Littleton. She was the wife of the late Paul D. Fletcher.

She was born in Whitman on April 23, 1907, and moved to Littleton in 1929.

Mrs. Fletcher had been a member of The Congregational Church of Littleton since 1944, where she served as a deacon for five years. She was head of the candy committee for the annual church fair for many years, and had also worked on the church's other committees.

Mrs. Fletcher was an original investor in the Nashoba Valley ski area in Westford, which was owned by her son, Alan W. Fletcher.

During World War II, she was a member of the Littleton Ration Board, and the Littleton Sewing Club for 72 years, which knitted for boys in the service. She had also been a guide at the Louisa May Alcott home in Concord for several years.

Survivors include two daughters, Ann Fletcher Simonds of Summerland Key, Fla., and Susan Fletcher Beane of Weston; a son, Alan W. Fletcher of Acton; nine grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; as well as several nieces and nephews.
