Alice Marie (Smith) Shimmel, age 72, of Littleton, passed away peacefully with her family by her side on Wednesday, February 28, 2024, at Dana Farber Brigham after living with cancer over the past year. She was the loving and devoted wife of John “Jack” Shimmel.

Alice was an avid reader and enjoyed word searches, crosswords, puzzles, and crafts. Her caring and compassionate demeanor was admired by all who knew her.

Along with her husband Jack, she is survived by her children, Jessica Hayes and husband Michael of Ayer; Nicholas Shimmel and wife Jennifer of Quincy and Alison Polzin and husband Ben of Grand Rapids, Michigan; her grandson Jaxson Shimmel; brothers Greg, Timothy and David Smith and many nieces and nephews.
