Gertrude Ferrari

Gertrude M. (Sheerin) Ferrari, 76, of Shattuck Street died Wednesday, July 27, 1994, after a brief illness. She was born in Boston, Oct. 30, 1917, daughter of the late Francis and Marie (Hailer) Sheerin and wife of the late John L. Ferrari, who died in 1973.

Mrs. Ferrari spent her early life in New York where she attended schools there. Upon her return to Massachusetts she resided in Jamaica Plain. Mrs. Ferrari and her husband resided in Littleton since 1950 and she was employed at the Rolling Pin Bake Shop in Littleton from 1960-1984, and was affectionately known by all the children who came to the store as "Auntie Gert."

She was a past member of the Littleton Council on Aging and a past treasurer of the St. Anne's Sodality as well as long-time parishioner. She is survived by her daughters Kathleen Falt of Nashua, N.H. and Mrs. Michael (Karen) Tuomi of Groton; three sisters Theresa Healey of Chelmsford, Mary Quinn of Somerville, and Joan Hurley of Colorado Springs, Colo.; three grandchildren Amanda K. Falt of Nashua, N.H. and John M. and Brian H. Tuomi both of Groton and many nieces and nephews. She was also the niece of Viola Duggan of Roslindale.
