GARDNER — Carmen N. Grigg Sr., formerly of Littleton, where he had run a printing shop for many years, died Monday, May 28, at his home in Gardner. He was 63.

He was born in Prince Edward Island in Canada on Jan. 18, 1938, a son of Eldon and Hazel (Palmer) Grigg of Prince Edward Island. He was raised in Prince Edward Island and immigrated to the United States as a teenager, settling in Cambridge. He lived in Cambridge for five years, before moving to Littleton in 1963.

Mr. Grigg worked as a printer his entire career. He was the longtime owner and operator of Grigg Printing in Littleton. He had previously worked at Barnard Printing in Boston.

He was a member of St. Andrews Episcopal Church in Ayer. Mr. Grigg was a Shriner, and a member of the Charles Welch Masonic Lodge in Maynard.

Besides his parents, survivors include his four children, Irene, L. Quinn of Leominster, Timothy E. Grigg of Gardner, Brian T. Grigg of Dracut and Carmen N. Grigg Jr. of Acton; and seven grandchildren, Nicole, John and Emily Quinn, Katherine, Molly, Thomas and Elise Grigg.
