CHELMSFORD — Diana (Cole) Gray, a long-time Chelmsford resident who had also lived in Littleton and Concord, Mass., died Sunday, March 26, at Lowell General Hospital. She was 61.

She was born in Boston on March 8, 1939, a daughter of the late Horatio and Violet (Hicks) Cole and was the former wife of Robert Gray, who died in 1988.
