LITTLETON — Stanley J. Glowacki, 67, of 7 Green Street, Littleton died at the Edith Nourse Rogers Veterans Hospital in Bedford on Sunday after a lengthy illness.

He was born in Easthampton, Mass. May 25, 1919, son of the late Stanley and Roaslia (Marchewka) Glowacki. Stanley spent his early life in Easthampton and was a graduate of Easthampton High School Class of 1936.

He served in the U.S. Army during World War II, where he was stationed in the Pacific. After the war Mr. Glowacki worked at the Hartnett Tannery in Ayer until 1961, the Harvard Observatory from 1962 until 1971, and most recently at the Haartz Auto Fabric of Acton until 1982.

He was a communicant of St. Anne's Church of Littleton and The Holy Name Society.

His survivors include his wife, Mona (Shanahan) Glowacki of Littleton; a son, Robert Glowacki of Cohasset; three daughters, Mrs. Philip (Carole) Levendusky of Concord, Mrs. Terrence (Mona Louise) Gibbons of Townsend, and Mrs. Mylan (Barbara) Haugen of Colorado

Springs, Colorado; two brothers, Walter Glowacki of Southwick, and John Glowacki of Indianapolis, Indiana; two sisters, Jeanne Bielinski of Feeding Hills, and Alyce Brackoneski of Agawam.

He is also survived by four grandchildren, Jason Levensky, Jarrod Gibbons, Kristin Haugen and Christine Glowacki.
