Mona (Shanahan) Glowacki, 69, of 7 Green Street, Littleton, died Jan. 2, at the The Nashoba Community Hospital in Ayer after a brief illness.

She was born in Lowell Feb. 26, 1919, daughter of the late Owen and Annie Shanahan, and was the wife of the late Stanley J. Glowacki, who died in 1986.
