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Littleton Affordable Housing Trust (LAHT) FY26 Application for CPC Funding to support the Rental Assistance Program

The objective of the LAHT program is to provide rental assistance to eligible Littleton residents. It supports renters in need of financial assistance, using the Littleton Rental Assistance Program (LRAP).

The project is consistent with the Community Preservation Plan of Community Housing assistance.

Applicants for the program are vetted and recommended by the Elder and Human Services, and if eligible, rental assistance payments are made directly to the participating landlords.

The program helps residents stay in their homes during temporary setbacks, or until longer term issues are resolved.

*The Trust seeks funding for the program for the fiscal year starting July 1, 2025, in the amount of \$106,000 to support 20 families, providing \$500 in monthly assistance to each family, or the total rent amount if it is less than \$500. The Trust will use the unspent balance (\$13,833) from the \$90,000 voted at TM last year for FY25 rental assistance to achieve the projected FY26 spending budget of \$120,000.
