The Friends of the Reuben Hoar Library is an organization whose purpose is to interpret the Library's needs to the public and the public's needs to the Library.

Responsibilities of the Trustees and Friends are separate. The Friends operate independently from the Library, but in cooperation with the Trustees and Library Director.

The Friends is a supporting organization, but does not make library policy.

In cooperation with the Library Trustees, the Friends may raise money to supplement the financial support of the Library.

The Friends organization encourages volunteer service at the Library.

With the consent of the Library Trustees and the Library Director, the Friends may work toward specific goals, such as increased fiscal support or building needs.
